

Miss Wehselau Breaks Record In Backstroke

Merichen Wehselau, Hawaii's sensational young mermaid, broke her own Hawaiian record for the 50-yard backstroke during the trials held last evening at Punahou tank, preliminary to tomorrow's big meet.

Miss Wehselau negotiated the distance last evening in :38 3-5, which is three-fifths of a second better than the Hawaiian record which she established some time ago. It is hoped that she will do even better tomorrow night, even though she is entered in four different events and may be somewhat tired when the backstroke race is called.

The preliminaries last night brought out a swarm of entrants, betokening an exciting time tomorrow evening, when the "big show" comes off.
