

HONOLULU TO LOSE PROMISING SWIMMER

It has been announced that Estelle Cassidy will leave next fall for the coast where she will enter a girls' college in Palo Alto, California.

She is one of the star swimmers of the Outrigger Canoe club and was a member of the team which set the world record at 4:38 flat last Friday night for the 440 yards women's junior national relay championship.

The others members of the team were Lillie Bowmer, Helen Moses and Mariechen Wehselau. Estelle Cassidy has not been swimming regularly this season because of ear trouble but is expected to get back into swimming form when she takes up her residence on the coast.

She averages about 1:08 in the century and hits about :30 flat in the half century.
