ALL NATIONS TO SEND GIRLS TO BIG MEET

PARIS, July 5. — Entries of women's field and track athletic teams for the international meet to be held in Pershing stadium on August 20, have been received from Belgium, Switzerland, England, and Czechoslovakia. France will also enter the strongest women's team that has ever competed in an international meet.

The games will be held under the auspices of the Feminine Federation of France. This is a temporary amalgamation of two feminine French athletic federations between which there has been considerable rivalry.
