

# BILL HARRIS TO MAKE SWIM TOUR OF ANZAC LAND

## Outrigger Canoe Club Star to Sail Next Month for Visit to Southern Tanks

W. W. (Wild Bill) Harris, Outrigger Canoe club swimmer, has been invited to make a swimming tour of New Zealand and Australia by the Anzac swimming authorities and has accepted the offer. The cable of acceptance was forwarded Saturday.

Harris has planned to leave here next month but the ship on which he had figured to sail goes direct to Sydney, whereas his orders from the Australian officials are to stop off at Auckland and swim for a month through New Zealand, going across to Australia later on, for a two months' tour.

### Wanted Duke

Some time ago the Australian and New Zealand swimming associations cabled here asking for Duke Kahanamoku. Duke was unavailable and so effort was made to get either Sam Kahanamoku, Warren Kealoha or Bill Harris. Warren could not go owing to having been recently married. Sam is in school and so the burden of maintaining Hawaii's reputation for swimming fell to Harris.

Harris felt that he should stay with his work and it was only by dint of some persuasion on the part of those interested in swimming that he was brought around to going. He is expected to return to Honolulu early next March.
