

# Dredging Project Will Aid Waikiki

Hawaii will present a gift to the travel world on Christmas Day.

On that date Waikiki beach will cease to be a deposit dump for the waters and debris flowing down the Manoa stream between the Moana hotel and the Outrigger Canoe Club.

The Reclamation Canal dredger in six weeks time, or less, will tap the Manoa stream and divert the waters of that rivulet into the canal.

The lower side of the stream will be banked up so that the waters of the canal will not flow into it.

The stream site from the canal to the beach will become dry. This will permit the sea to wash up a sand barrier and the beach will again come into being as a real sandy beach. It is possible that the area in front of the Seaside hotel may again fill up with sand.

It is certain that there will be no more breaking down of the beach between the Moana and the Outrigger sites.

The stream site is the property of the Queen Emma Estate. The Territorial Hotels company has a lease, it is reported, on the stream bed adjoining the Moana. It is possible that the hotel may have the bed filled up with dredgings from the canal so that there will be a continuous stretch of land, and the stream will become only a memory.
