

OUTRIGGER CREEK TO BE MEMORY; WAIKIKI BEACH MAY PROFIT

Within the course of the next few weeks, the ill-smelling stream which has separated the property of the Outrigger Canoe Club from that of the Manoa hotel promises to become only a memory, as the waters from Manoa valley which fed it will soon be diverted into the canal that is being dredged on the mauka side of Kalakaua Ave.

Experts believe that this may permit the ocean to build up a long sandy beach at Waikiki that may extend in front of the Seaside hotel site.

The stream bed is the property of the Queen Emma estate and is under lease to the Territorial Hotels Co., owners of the Moana, and it is rumored that the company may have it filled while the dredger is in the vicinity.
