

NEW OFFICERS IN FOR SOCCER RING

Schedule Drawn Up and Four Teams Enter for the Coming Season

Soccer, a sport which seemed about to droop and die in Honolulu, suddenly took a new lease of life and showed a surprising amount of rejuvenation when at a meeting last night in the British club four teams entered the league and a schedule was drawn up for the coming season, as well as new officers elected for the association.

Fred Harrison, president, was not allowed to resign because it was felt that his entire support would be needed in making the league a success this season. George (Dad) Center was elected vice president and C. F. L. Walker was chosen secretary-treasurer.

The Teams

The four teams that entered the league were Outriggers, Rangers, Honolulu United and Schofield. Substitution will probably be allowed in soccer during the coming season, which should help to create interest among the reserve players, who will have more chance to break into the game than under the old system.

Goalposts will go up on Makiki field December 1, and the use of the grounds has been given the association from that date until March 15, 1923.
