

# BEACH CLUB REPORTS HEALTHY FINANCES

The Outrigger Canoe club reported a healthy financial condition at the recent annual meeting, according to the statement filed by the treasurer, Percy G. H. Deverill and the auditor H. A. Asch.

The club's income during the past year from dues, initiation fees, commissary profit and football gains amounted to \$16,159.07. The expenditures, including operating expenses and the athletic department were \$12,871.28. This left an income over expenses of \$3287.79 but out of this came expenditures for a washing machine, watchman's clock and bathing suits leaving a net income after all expenditures of \$2942.92.

Athletic expenditures in the past year were listed as canoe department \$444.73; volleyball \$93.34; swimming, \$665.81; track, \$74.71; soccer, \$65.80 and basketball \$148.58. This made a total of \$1492.96. The general operating expenses of the club were \$11,378.32.
