

Star Program Lined Up For Women's Auxiliary Meet For Olympic Fund

Entry Blanks Out Friday, and Lists Are to Close on
Monday; Popular Prices Will
Prevail This Time

ENTRY blanks for the first pre-Olympiad swimming meet, to be held in Punahou tank under the auspices of the Women's auxiliary of the Outrigger club, will be available at the office of the secretary of the A.A.U. on and after Friday morning, and entries will close on Monday morning, January 14.

The auxiliary held a meeting yesterday and a program for the two-day meet was agreed upon.

On Friday night, January 13, trials in all events where they are required, will be held and in addition men's plain high diving and women's springboard diving will be offered. There will be no admission charge on this night.

On Saturday night, January 19, the program will include a most varied set of events staged here in a long time. Special interest will be aroused by the handicap events which offer competition de luxe for the crack swimmers of the islands. On Saturday night a 25-cent admission charge will be made, the funds to be turned over to the Women's Auxiliary Olympic fund.

The Saturday program, to be run off in the order named, is:

Women's high diving.

Men's 100 yards open.

Women's 100 yards backstroke.

Boys under 15, 100 yards.

Women's 220-yard handicap.

Men's springboard diving.

Girls under 15, 50 yards.

Men's 100-yard backstroke handicap.

Women's 220 yards breaststroke handicap.

Men's 220 yards open.

Women's 50 yards backstroke novice.

Men's 440-yard handicap.

Women's 200-yard relay.

The purpose of this meet is two-fold. First, it will offer additional racing experience to the swimmers who are trying for the Olympic team, and, secondly, it will add to the Olympic fund already held by the Auxiliary which has set aside the proceeds of its last two meets for that purpose.
