

DATES ARE SET FOR WATER POLO

Championship Series Will Be Played Early In March

March 5, 6 and 7 have been set as the dates for the playing of the Hawaiian A. A. U. water polo championship contests. The matches will be held either in Punahou or the University tank.

Six teams have announced their intention of entering the tourney. The Outrigger Club, Hui Makani, Hui Nalu, Y. M. C. A., Army and Navy squads will be in the fracas. This will mean at least five and perhaps six matches, according to the Bergvall system of drawing. It is not likely that any swimming events will be held in connection with the games, as all of the club stars will be playing on their teams. It will be Hawaii's first chance to show that their water stars excel at events other than straight swimming.

Team entries are to be made to Norman Ross, chairman of the water polo committee, by March 1.
