dianapolis. The original dates set were June 13 and 14, but the change has been made in order to allow the successful contestants to prepare for their departure on the S. S. America, which will sail with the American Olympic team from New York on June 16.

Program

The rearranged program for the final tryouts has been given out as follows:

Thursday, June 5-100 meters free style; 1500 meters free style and springboard diving.

Friday, June 6-400 meters free style and 100 meters backstroke.

Saturday, June 7—200 meters free style, 200 meters backstroke, relay trials, plain and fancy high diving.

The women's trials will be held in New York in the week ending June 14.
