Change 800 Meters To 880 Yds. To Give Borg Chance To Try For World Record

When the entries had finally been sorted out and tabulated yesterday evening the list for the Olympic harbor swimming meet, Friday, Saturday and Sunday, proved a good sized one and showed the pick of Hawaii's swim talent.

The officials have announced that the 800 meters for Friday has been changed to the half mile in order to give Arne Borg, Swedish swimmer, a chance at the record made by Andrew Charlton. Borg is swimming in the 200 meters and 400 meters also.
