

WOMEN WATER STARS IN FAST TRYOUTS TODAY

Aileen Riggin Heads List of 135 Entries.

BRIARCLIFF MANOR, N. Y., June 6.—Final Olympic tryouts for the American women's swimming team will be held here tomorrow and Sunday with contestants including practically all of the leading feminine aquatic performers of the United States, Canal Zone, and Hawaiian Islands. One hundred and thirty-five entries, including numerous National champions, and world's record holders, have been received for the meet.

The list is headed by Aileen Riggin, of New York, who won the fancy diving title at the Antwerp Olympics four years ago; Miss Gertrude Ederle, New York, champion middle distance performer; Miss Helen Wainwright, New York, all-around star; Miss Betty Becker, Atlantic City, N. J., diving champion; Miss Sybil Baur, Chicago, leading backstroke swimmer and Mariechen Wehselau, brilliant Hawaiian contender.
