Warren Kealoha, Pua Kealoha and Sam Kahanamoku have been invited, and an offer of \$1000 towards their expenses has been made. This sum would not cover their entire expenses were they to be brought from here and returned right after the contests, but in view of the fact that a month later the same three will have to be sent to Indianapolis anyway, and brought back again after the Olympics, the sum is more than enough to keep them in Chicago or Indianapolis for the extra month, giving them the chance of training at the place they will have to swim the trials. In addition Hawaii will be represented in what promises to be the biggest meet of many years.\*
