

# Twelve Event Card For the Aquatic Meet Coming March

## Four Hawaiian Championships To Be Run Off—Business Girls Are Listed On Program

The tentative program for the third Hawaiian swimming meet, to be held under the auspices of the Women's Auxiliary on March 12 at the Y. M. C. A. tank, has twelve listed events, with more to come if it is decided that other events than those listed would be of advantage.

Beside the 50-yard men's national championship senior division race, the four feature events will be the 100-yard Hawaiian championship swim, the 50-yard Hawaiian breast stroke event, the diving contests for the Island championship, the 50-yard back stroke Hawaiian championship and the plunge for distance for the Island records.

In addition to these events the program will include the 40-yard swim for business girls, which event will not be open to club members; the 40-yard event for girls from the public schools, which will be run off under the same conditions as the 40-yard event for business girls, and a 20-yard swim for girls under 12 years of age.

A club relay for teams of four girls, swimming 40 yards each, will be one of the squad features, as will another relay for schoolgirls, who will swim 20 yards apiece, each team being composed of six girls.

A diving exhibition by junior division aquatic performers will be one of the novelty features of the program. Other events will be added at the discretion of the committee in charge of the affair. Rules governing entry and starting will be drawn up, and definition of the scope of the terms "business" or "school" girls will be given its final ruling.
