The seventh Outrigger Club, held in Astoria, Oregon, last year Hawaii sent one of its mermaids and gave eight or nine girls a try.

THEY credit for adding to a record that in several instances would be credited to Mrs. E. P. Jones, a resident of the Hawaiian Islands, who was the first to make a record for a woman, which was held in the "Coral" in 1911. Later Mrs. P. 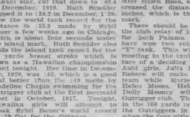
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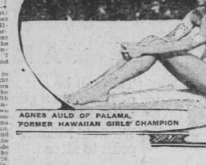


AGNES HAUL OF PALAMA, FORMER AUSTRALIAN GIRL CHAMPION

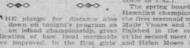
