

Bathing Suits and Modesty

The education committee, reporting on Senator S. L. Desha's "bathing suit bill," S. B. 59, amended it to require that no person over 12 years of age shall appear in a public place, except on the beach or in the water, "within the district of Kona, Honolulu," in a bathing suit or such covering "as does not cover his or her body modestly." Penalty, \$50 and, or, a year's imprisonment.
