

BUSTER BROWN SHOWS UP WELL IN FIFTY YARDS

"Buster" Brown of the Outrigger Canoe club surprised a lot of swimming fans last night by taking first place in the second heat of the 50 yards men's junior national championship. W. W. "Wild Bill" Harris of the Outrigger club took first place in the first heat as expected. Harris made it in :25 flat while Brown's time was :25.4.

Brown becomes a possibility for second and third place in the event tonight because of his showing last night. Sam Kahanamoku took second place to Bill Harris and "John Dee" Kaupiko of the Hui Nalus third. Behind Brown in the second heat came Mahu of the Healanis then Gay Harris with George Kane in fourth place.

In the century novice Todd of the Hui Makani won the first heat in the 100 yards novice in a minute flat. Keawe was second and Thompson third. "Buster" Brown again stepped into the limelight by taking first place in the second heat. His time was 1:01.4. Erdman was second, Mahu third and Kainoa fourth.
