OCC survives in volleyball

Seven of the nation's top volleyball men teams posted victories yesterday to advance into the third round of the winners bracket in the 41st U.S. Volleyball National Open Championship competition at Klum and McKinley Gyms.

The seven join top seeded Chart House San Diego which posted its second qualifying victory by defeating a stubborn Windjammer Bullet team, 15-3, 16-14, late Wednesday night in the 16th hour of the day's volleyball action.

ALONG WITH the San Diego club in the third round which starts today are Hawaii's Outrigger White, UCLA, U.S. Armed Forces, Ciscos, C and H Gold Los Angeles, Balboa Bay Club and second seeded San Francisco Olympic Club.

The key third round clash starts 11:45 a.m. when Chart House, very impressive in its two wins, meets Outrigger White. UCLA faces U.S. Armed Forces at 12:30 p.m. and Ciscos plays C and H Gold L.A., and Balboa meets Olympic both at 1:45.

The winners enter the fourth round which will be played 8 and 9:15 tonight, all at Klum Gym.

The third round will be played 4:15 and 5:30 p.m., and the fourth round is at 8 and 9:15 tonight at Klum.

The senior men's winner bracket resumes after a day of rest yesterday, with third round games 12:30 and 1:45 p.m. today at McKinley and

their semi-finals 5:30 p.m. Outrigger Canoe Club. Ken Allen Chicago, Balboa and Long Beach are the contenders.

LOSER'S bracket competition progressed yesterday in all three divisions as teams were eliminated as they suffered their second loss in the double elimination play.

Hawaii teams out of the tourney because of two losses are the women's Honolulu YMCA, Kuuipos and Church College.

In the crucial games yesterday, the men's Olympic

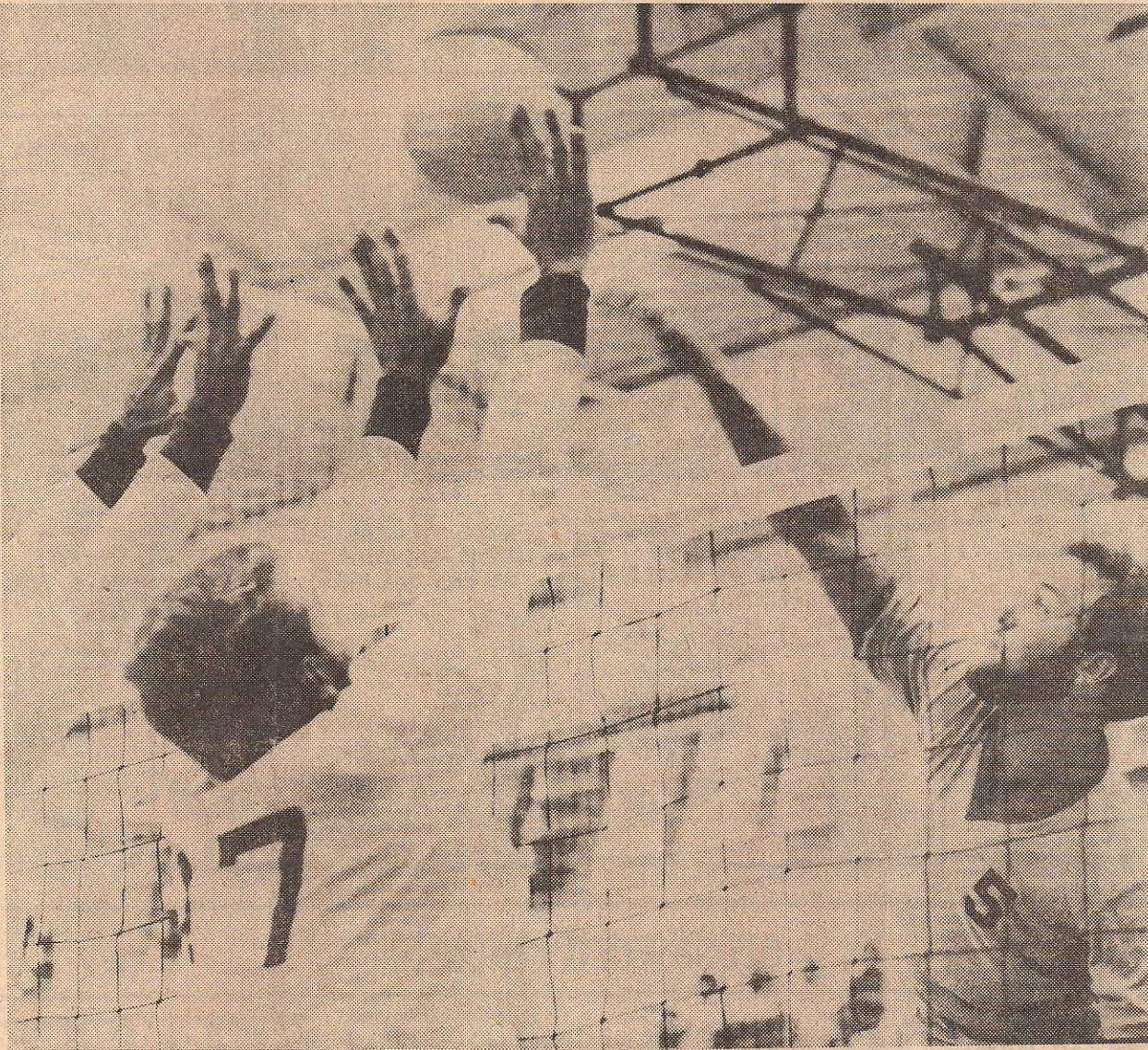

Outrigger White also rallied and defeated Ken Allen Chicago White, 14-16, 15-11, 15-11, and UCLA downed Dallas YMCA, 15-5, 15-9, in other second round men's games.

In the women's second round winners bracket, Nuuanu YMCA nipped the South Bay Mavericks, 14-12, 12-10, but Hawaii's two other entries, Honolulu YBA and Keaukaha suffered losses.

Top ranked and powerful Los Angeles Shamrocks crushed YBA, 15-1, 15-6 and Windjammer II defeated Keaukaha, 15-8, 13-10.

About 1,000 spectators watched yesterday's nine hours of volleyball. A luau for all the players was held at the Princess Kaiulani Hotel last night.

The competition resumes at 8:45 a.m. at Klum Gym for the women and men's open winners and losers bracket, and 8:45 a.m. at McKinley Gym for the senior men's winners and losers.
